







Our shelter was lucky enough to be able to celebrate our 40th Anniversary this past year. We promise to keep improving every year to continue to make Wanderers' Rest Humane Association, Inc. the best that it can be!

In 2021, we adopted out 232 animals (82 dogs and 150 cats), while 118 animals were returned to their owners. Our live release rate was 96.97%. We are so proud of this as we continue to meet the guidelines of No-Kill and our own Care and Compassion title.

We hosted three big events last year: Bone Appetit, Woofstock, and Poker, Paws, & Passion. All three events went very well and we are excited to see how much bigger and better we can make these events this year.

In addition, WRHA was thrilled to finally start the Veterans Canine Training Program at Mid-State Correctional Facility. We have had two successful rounds of training (currently on our third) and are proud to be making such a great impact.

After the continued impact of COVID-19, the best thing to happen this past year was opening our doors back up to public walk-ins. Once we opened, our adoptions appeared to increase and our involvement with the public also improved. To go with this, we have created new hours to allow individuals with varying work schedules to be able to visit our shelter at some point. We are now open Monday—Friday from 12pm to 6pm, Saturday from 12pm to 4pm, and Sunday by appointment only.

We can not wait to see what 2022 brings us!
